



## Dragonfly Baby Bib

### Materials:

- Yarn: ½ Skein of Cotton Tots yarn
- Loom: Fine Gauge loom with at least 32 pegs. Baby Hat Loom was used in sample.
- Notions: Crochet hook, Large eye needle, Button (optional)

**Size:** 8-inches Wide, 7 inches Long

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**Pattern notes:** Done in single stitch with the e-wrap and knitted in a flat panel. Decrease stitch knowledge

needed.

### DIRECTIONS

Cast on 32sts

R1-36: Work in single stitch. Cut yarn leaving a 6-inch tail.

Next row: ss11, bo10, ss11.

### Shaping

\*Next row: k2tog, ss9

Next row: ss10\*

Repeat from \* to \* until only 6sts remain. Bind off with Basic Removal Method.

Attach yarn to the other side (to peg 1 of the first 11 pegs) and repeat Shaping section, except the bind off.

Continue on the 6 remaining pegs.

Next row: ss

Next row: p

Repeat until you have about 8 inches in length. Bind off.

### Finishing

Attach button to the short side.

Crochet 2 rows of single crochet all around the bib.

### Abbreviations

**ss:** Single stitch/Twisted Knit stitch

**bo:** Bind off

**k2tog:** Knit 2 stitches together. Move loop from outer peg one peg over. Treat both loops as one

**R:** Row

**p:** purl
